Junior Secondary is a phase of education in state secondary schools for Years 7, 8 and 9, which helps to ensure the bridge between primary and secondary school is safe, strong and consistent for all students.

Junior Secondary focuses on age-appropriate education, and support for students' wellbeing and transitions.

Junior Secondary is underpinned by six guiding principles - distinct identity, quality teaching, student wellbeing, parent and community involvement, leadership and local decision-making.

All Queensland state high schools began the implementation of Junior Secondary for Years 8 and 9 from 2013.

Year 7 at Eidsvold State School is already included in our Secondary School Department.

If your child is in Years 7-9 they are in Junior Secondary.

The six guiding Principles for Junior Secondary are :

Distinct Identity

Local Decision Making

Leadership

Parent and community involvement

Quality Teaching

Student Wellbeing

Some of the current programs and activities we have in place as part of our Junior Secondary are:

- Transition classes. Year 7 students are currently undertaking math lessons with the secondary math teacher Mr Brunjes one day a week.
- Additional literacy and numeracy classes for all students in year 7-9.
- Distinctive leadership opportunities at levels of school in the Junior Secondary Years
- Junior Secondary display board in the secondary area
- Learning and Wellbeing activities with care teacher and interagency personnel
- Distinctive uniform to be introduced in 2015
- Our teachers of Junior Secondary have all attended training sessions to enhance their capabilities around Junior Secondary teaching and learning.
