Our school performance data indicates that a significant percentage of our current students have acceptable academic results however, this year our goal is to bump students currently sitting on a satisfactory standard into the upper two bands across Mathematics and English. In 2022, a case-by-case approach across our P-12 setting has been developed to work with our full teaching staff around student achievement. Our recent A-E data illustrates a direct correlation between targeted support and academic outcomes. Our goal is for all students to improve by at least 10% across the school year and lift A-C data in secondary English and Mathematics. Our approach is aligned to the Central Queensland Regional priorities, School Improvement Review recommendations and our Annual Implementation Plan 2022.

Our goal is to ensure consistency of expectations across a Prep- Year 12 setting. Investing for success funding will be used to purchase an additional teacher and teacher aide fraction and build their capabilities with a specific focus on improving student numeracy and literacy outcomes.

Using funding to employ a teacher to work with current student data and inform teaching practices in response to data trends. Part of this role will be working collaboratively with the teaching team on strategies to lift upper two band data in all classrooms including: improving Year 7 -12 U2B rates from 42% to 55%, Increasing overall school A-C data to above 90% with consistent moderation practices.	\$45,266
